Informal learning environment Dr. Gitanjali Choudhury


- 1.Flexibility and Spontaneity in Informal learning environment are found which has no predefined curriculum or schedule.
- 2.Learners have the flexibility to explore topics of interest at their own pace.
- 3.Learners are the main focus of this environment curiosity, interests, and needs.
- 4. Real-world experiences, conversations, online resources, books, videos are the various learning sources in informal learning environment.
- 5.Social interaction, such as discussions, collaboration, and sharing of knowledge are found in informal learning.
- 6.Learning takes place sometimes through observation and interaction with others.
- 7. Learning by doing and real-world experiences, trial-and-error, experimentation, and hands-on activities are common in informal learning which is known as experiential learning.

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- 8. Learners are self-directed. They take their own responsibility in learning. Learners are independent to achieve their goals.
- 9. Informal learning is a Continuous and Lifelong Learning. People can take education at any stage of a life.
- 10. Contextual and Practical aspects are the main focus of informal learning.
- 11. Online resources, social media, and mobile apps are the main sources of informal learning . For information and communication, learners can use digital platforms also.
- 12. Homes, workplaces, community spaces, or online platforms are the different settings in informal learning situations.
- 13.No rigid structures or formal assessments are found in informal learning situations.
- 14. Informal learning allows individuals to assess their learning experiences as their specific needs and preferences.

Disadvantage of Informal learning

- 1. There is a lack of structure in informal learning which may not cover all the topics or skills with proper plans.
- 2. There is no consistency in Learning Quality with proper information
- 3.Limited Assessments are used in informal settings of learning in which learners can not show their knowledge and skills on their subject.
- 4. Not found proper guidance. So the learners sometimes get misinformation or biased content.
- 5.Lack of motivation and self-discipline are found in informal environment.
- 6. Sometimes, learners take too much time for getting their goals due to their accountability on their courses.
- 7.All learners are not equally trained for assessing the learning resources due to their economic conditions.



- 9. No all rounded education is found here . Informal learning might not covered essential foundational knowledge of the topic.
- 10. Variability in the development of skills is found. It is difficult to assess the proficiency of individuals due to the lack of standardized outcomes of the learners.
- 11. Diverse social and cultural factors are found in informal learning experiences.
- 12. It is a challenging task for the informal learners to engaze themselves consistently.
- 13. Informal learning depends on the availability of time for exploration and selfdirected study.

Non-formal learning environment

- 1.Non-formal learning environment allows the learners to participate at their own pace and convenience in flexible manner.
- 2.No fixed schedules and locations are found.
- 3. Anyone can assess the learning opportunities with various commitments or limitations.
- 4. This type of education does not incline to provide structured qualifications or degree.
- 5. Learners enrolled in this type of learning for personal or professional development.
- 6. workshops, seminars, online courses, mentorship programs, self-directed learning, and experiential activities etc. are the diverse learning methods in this type of learning environment.

- 7. Practical, applied knowledge and skills rather than theoretical understanding are the main focus points in this type of learning which is frequently oriented toward real-world applications and problem-solving.
- 8.Non-formal learning allows the individuals to choose learning opportunities as their personal interests, career goals, or specific needs.
- 9. Diverse group of participants with different backgrounds, ages, and experiences are found in non-formal learning. This diversity enriches the learning experience by fostering the exchange of varied perspectives and ideas.
- 10.Short-Term and Lifelong Learning are found in non-formal learning environment for providing targeted knowledge and skills.

- 11.various settings outside traditional classrooms, such as community centers, workplaces, online platforms, or informal community groups can be the centre for non-formal institutions.
- 12. It allows the learners to take participate actively as their interests .
- 13.Non-formal education is linked with the changing societal needs, emerging trends, or specific demands in the job market.
- 14.It allows the learners to build on existing knowledge and skills with prior learning experiences.
- 15. It has diverse and dynamic nature of learning environment.

Disadvantages of Non-formal learning environment

- 1. No Formal Recognition is given by this type of institutions.
- 2. There are variations in the quality of instruction which makes it challenging for learners to assess the reliability and credibility of the learning experience.

- 3. There is limited structure of curriculum and guidance which hampers the learners for getting their learning at the level best.
- 4.Inconsistency is found in content, delivery, and assessment due to the delivery of diverse resource persons which brings lack of uniformity on the reliability and comparability of the learning experience.
- 5. Educational inequalities are found in non-formal learning due to financial constraints, geographic location, or other socio-economic factors.
- 6.Job opportunities and career advancement are hampered because some organations may not recognize the qualifications given by non-formal institutions.
- 7. No standardized assessment are done to evaluate the learners' outcomes.

- 8. There is lack of discipline and commitment among learners due to the informality among the learners.
- 9. Without a standardized curriculum, there is a risk that learners may miss essential foundational knowledge or skills, leading to gaps in their overall understanding in non-formal education.
- 10. Individuals who lack intrinsic motivation may find it challenging to complete non-formal courses or programs successfully.
- 11. Fewer network opportunities are used in non-formal learning due to less formalized settings.
- 12. It is difficult for learners to gauge their progress and for institutions to evaluate the impact of their programs due to the lack of standardized evaluation.

Virtual Learning Environment

- 1.A Virtual Learning Environment (VLE) refers to an online platform or digital space designed to facilitate and support education through the use of various digital tools and resources.
- 2. It is known as a Learning Management System (LMS) or an e-learning platform,

- 5.To track and analyze student progress, participation, and engagement, VLE provides data and analytics tools for educators to make informed decisions.

- 6. VLE ensures accessibility for learners with different technological capabilities with the Support for various devices (computers, tablets, smart phones) to ensure accessibility for learners with different technological capabilities.
- 7. Video conferencing, interactive simulations, or third-party applications can be done in VLE.
- 8.VLE can ensure the security and privacy of user data, compliance with data protection regulations, and secure login/authentication processes.

Disadvantages of VLE

- 1. Internet connectivity is not assessable for all types of learners.

- 3. Learners do not get equal educational opportunities due to the use of Digital Inequality.

- 4. Virtual learning may lack the face-to-face social interactions which affects the development of social skills and a sense of community.
- 5.VLE has less teacher-student interaction which establishes poor relationship among student-trainees.
- 6.VLE can ensure the security and privacy of user data, compliance with data protection regulations, and secure login/authentication processes.
- 7.In VLE, if students remain at home, they can find distractions and as a result, their main focus on education could be lost.
- 8. Students in VLE, can be lost in their concentration due to their use of multitasking effort during class.
- 9.students may have easier access to external resources or assistance during examination time in VLE.
- 10. Teachers may be faced extra workload in VLE because they have to know latest technology of digital world.
